4. Photos of applicant for posting on Alpine's website submitted with application.

The award must be used to cover skating expenses. Awarded funds will be disbursed directly to a coach, a skating rink/facility, or a vendor for skating apparel or equipment. NO funds will be disbursed directly to an applicant or their parent.
